Moving In



Mr. Gus is 67-years-old and raises his two granddaughters, who are 4 and 6-years-old. He lives on a limited income while also getting some help from the Department of Children and Families and the granddaughters' father. Mr. Gus was a plumber for 15 years, but retired a few years ago due to a disability.

Struggling to make ends meet along with the expenses of taking care of his grandchildren, he signed up for HUD housing and was finally approved after a two-year wait. Mr. Gus found a house and contacted ElderSource requesting assistance to pay the deposit and first month's rent.

Thanks to the Senior to Senior Program, Mr. Gus and his granddaughters were able to move into their new home.

A True Transformation



Mrs. Nancy is a widow and has lived in the same house for 29 years. However, for the past few years the home fell into severe disrepair.

Although several nonprofit organizations assisted her, not all the repairs could be made.

Earlier this year, Mrs. Nancy was cited by the City for several violations and was given 30 days to comply or pay a fine. When funds ran short Hart Felt Ministries and Builder's Care turned to ElderSource for assistance.

Through our Senior to Senior II Program, ElderSource was able to assist by paying Builder's Care to not only complete final roof repairs and the remaining tasks to comply with the citation, but Mrs. Nancy received help that truly transformed her home.

The Senior to Senior Program is an endowment created by J.Wayne and Delores Barr Weaver coordinated through the Community Foundation of Northeast Florida to assist seniors facing an unexpected financial crisis. The program is also generously supported by a grant from the Jim Moran Foundation.
